## Joyful good news from Council

Save the date. Town hall meeting April 28 between the services. This is an opportunity for the congregation to share ideas and suggestions or ask questions about Joy services and ministries. It is informal and an open forum.

Joy Concerts continue to be in good hands but have grown to be more than one person (Silas) can handle. The council approved a proposal presented at the February Council meeting to form the Concert Series Oversight Committee. This committee will coordinate with other Joy ministries to ensure every concert is completely planned including hospitality, ushers, safety, clean-up, sound, Sanctuary set-up, etc. All those things that are essential for our performers and audience.

The Council welcomed Intern Bob Bonomo to Joy. Bob wishes to sit in on ministry meetings to see how we roll. We look forward to sharing all that we have going on at Joy.

The Joy House driveway repair began on March 22. Completed with this project will be the final grading of the hole that has been started for the stormwater retention pond associated with the sidewalk improvement project, that remains scheduled for April 22, pending the building permit. We will not be able to walk on the new sidewalk for several days once completed, so that may hinder the use of the rear door to the building.

In other good news, the Joy Safety and Security sub-committee, as part of Member Care, has been formed. At this time, there are 13 volunteers that have the safety of our congregation at heart, striving to be leaders in AED training, passive security measures, 911 call protocol, and relieve the usher teams of the responsibility of locking doors. They will greet late comers with a big smile and assist in making them feel welcomed. This team will meet monthly to discuss and plan for the safety of our congregation and guests during services and events. Consider joining the Safety effort, they could use additional volunteers.

<u>December 7, 2024</u> - Plans are underway for this luncheon and entertainment is Pat Gates, from The Way.


## **ALTAR FLOWERS**
