ship, or growth – without being spiritually connected and on board with what God is doing. We are pretty good at *doing church*, but it is more important to **be** the body of Christ for the sake of the world. That world hits us as soon as we exit the gate of OTOW, Oak Run, Spruce Creek, Stone Creek, or get on SR 200 (praying

mightily!). The Holy Spirit equips us, sends us out on our spiritual journey. My sense is that we will adopt a vision that captures the kind of people we want to be: reaching out to help people become spiritually connected in a crazy world. A WOW! Factor that will be implemented by and with what we already do –

worship, service, and fellowship. This process must be bathed, saturated in prayer. I would love to see intentional prayer groups or circles emerge in our congregation. You do not need my approval or even oversight. Start with two or three people. Do it anywhere, anytime.

We are in shared ministry; partners for the sake of the gospel. Pray for the vision that the Holy Spirit is guiding us toward. Share your thoughts, hopes, and dreams for sharing the love of Christ with a weary world.

Commitment
