Dear JOYful family,

“The goal of our instruction is love from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith.” (I Timothy 1:5)

For me, and perhaps for you, one of the road signs I dread the most is “Road Narrows”. My grip on the steering wheel gets tighter, my pulse and heart rate pick up, and I brace myself for whatever hazardous driving condition is about to unfold. More often than not, it ends up being no big deal. Jesus tells us that the road is narrow to the

kingdom of heaven, and few will enter through the gate. That is a far more dreadful portent than a road sign. Our Lord also instructs us that weeds will grow among wheat, sprinkled with seeds of bitterness, resentment, or condemnation. We rely on the Holy Spirit’s seeds planted in our heart, conscience, and faith. Many of you are green-thumbed master garden tenders and nur-

turers. We are all praying for rain as we experience drought-like conditions. We despair that our spring plantings are being held off or are just not producing.

My seminary preaching professor, a crusty old hambone from NC, would say (“...at...at...at that point”) “Whar’s the good news, preacher?” The answer I

*Marjorie Weiss was ordained into the ministry in 1980 when there were just 200 some Lutheran women pastors across the United States. A graduate of the Lutheran Theological Seminary in Philadelphia, she served congregations in Rome, Utica, and Schenectady; all in New York; as well as Danville, Pennsylvania. Her most recent call was in Wellington, Florida, from where she retired. Her journey was unique as a pioneer pastor with surprising highs as well as shocking lows. She wrote about her experiences in her award-winning memoir, *Praying on Empty, A Female Pastor's Story*, a book that touches reader's hearts with its honesty, humor, and depth of feeling as she describes her struggle with a loss of faith while still needing to continue her work in parish ministry.*

Her book is the winner of the Illumination Award Gold Medal in Inspirational Memoir and also a finalist in the INDIES Awards and The International Books Awards. She will have copies available when she addresses the WELCA group in May and it also is available on Amazon as a print or eBook. It is also available at other online retailers.

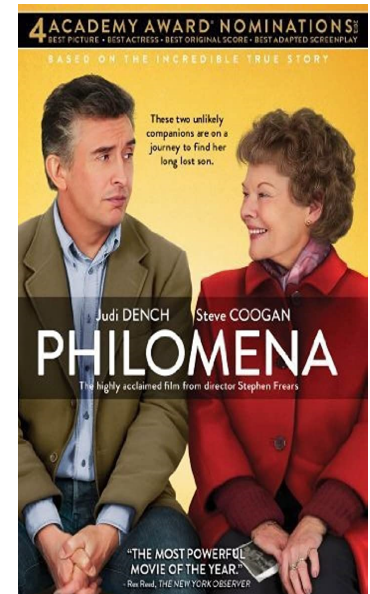
